Attend SEDL's "Disaggregation without Aggravation" Workshop

In light of increasing pressure to raise achievement, one of the biggest challenges schools face is making good use of assessment data. Districts and schools collect lots of data—from attendance information to test scores—but are often overwhelmed by it. And now with No Child Left Behind adequate yearly progress requirements, measuring progress by subgroups is more important than ever.

SEDL's new professional development workshop, *Disaggregation without Aggravation* introduces you and your staff to the basics of disaggregating student data and analyzing that data. You will learn what kind of data you should collect, how to break data into more meaningful subgroups, how to examine data across multiple dimensions, and how to identify subgroups for interventions. We encourage you to bring school data to

the workshop for additional practice with data that is meaningful to you. We will also discuss planning for data disaggregation and interpreting disaggregated data.
